



Temporary Notice to Mariners

Scour Repairs - Tay Viaduct, River Tay, Perth

Mariners are advised Amco-Giffen shall be undertaken repairs to the Tay Viaduct, Perth Railway Bridge, on behalf of Network Railway, between the 2nd September 2024 and 29th September 2024 (inclusive).

The works shall include scour repairs & preventative action to torn reno mattress and loss of infill material noted to Pier 2, 3, 4, 5, 18, 19 and 21. Backfill reno mattress with suitably sized stones and repair torn reno mattress to prevent further loss of material.

Amco-Giffen shall project manage the works with dive organisation CalDive in attendance.

Works shall be carried out around low tides for best access to the site.

During dive operations the 'A' flag shall be visible at all times. A rescue vessel shall be in attendance. The rescue vessel shall keep a listening watch on Ch6 and Ch9.

Diving will take place in compliance with the UK Diving at Work Regulations 1997, the Inland/Inshore Diving Projects Approved Code of Practice, and Caldive Limited diving procedures.

Mariners are advised to keep a safe distance from the dive site, and to contact XXXXX should you require to transit the dive location.
